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## **English Translation**

### **Who am I?**

My name is P V Krishnan or Parthasarathy Venkata Krishnan. I belong to Thiruvallikeni, Chennai. I am a Brahmanan. After studying 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> through CBSE in Chennai, I studied engineering in Mayiladuthurai. Then I got an opportunity to go to America on a full scholarship for a MS degree. After my MS degree, my first job was a Senior Electrical Design Engineer. I had grown like this only to be killed by over work and work pressure. My marriage in 2008 was cancelled because I had a mental breakdown. My eventual repeated breakdowns due to work pressure ensured that I now have schizophrenia and have been declared a disabled person in Singapore, Australia and India. I don't want the same to happen to your son or daughter. Did you read about the 25 year old girl who died in Ernest and Young in September 2024 due to work pressure. Don't let this be your loved one.

### **Why this Leaflet?**

I am creating this leaflet to request you to send your brahmana sons aged 7 and above to vedapadasalai. It is well known that kids who pursue veda adhyayanam will become wise at an early age and will not be carried away by ideas of achieving power and money. Thus, I believe that your sons will not do the same mistakes I did which is to run after padhavi and porul. Your sons after veda padasalai will be safe and grow into maturity after they finish their studies and become leaders of the modern world.

### **After veda padasalai. Higher Education? Join 10th, 12th, Degree, Medicine, Engineering?**

Veda Adhyayanam is only 8 years. So by age 14 or 15 your son will be back home ready to write his 10<sup>th</sup> standard exams. Please don't be tied up with Puthra-paasam and stop our next generation from learning our culture. You will be separated from your son only for 8 years. Nowadays 10<sup>th</sup> standard exams can be directly written through NIOS. We all must have heard about NIOS. A lot of veda padasalai already give NIOS coaching. But did you know? The state NIOS Centre is very near to us here in Thiruvallikeni itself. About 100 meters after we enter Avvai Shanmugham Salai from the beach near Vivekanandar Illam campus, it is on your right side. You can after your son returns from Veda Padasalai, go and enroll him for Xth by yourself. Then he can join any Hindu charity based schools in Chennai for regular 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> exams. After regular 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> exams he can write NEET to join medicine or join Engineering or IT courses as you may wish for your son.

### **Most important issue of Money**

Nowadays Schools charge a lot of money in the name of fees. Even LKG classes are costly. From the start of schooling in primary school to 10<sup>th</sup> standard, we spend around 40 thousand to 50 thousand or more per year. If we give a small part of this money to the veda padasalai where your son studies and put the rest as monthly payments into LIC education policies. Then these education policies will help you pay for your son's higher studies like medicine or engineering. Thus you will not have money pressure throughout your son's school years.

### **Ideal Case Scenario for brahmanas who did not study in veda padasalai:**

The reason for this leaflet is that we are noticing nowadays that our children are working harder and harder. They are spending almost 10 to 12 hours at work and can do nothing else. Especially the IT, engineering and medicine sectors have become jobs for abrahmanas. IT, medicine and engineering fields were our sustenance but these fields are now squeezing the blood out of the workers by long work hours and too much work pressure. We all read about how a 25 year old young girl who had just finished her CA died due to over work in a US MNC – Ernest and Young in September 2024.



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There is a way to avoid this problem of work pressure, long work hours and having to move to far away cities for work. If we have sanskrit as a subject in school then we can take the basic degree course of B.A in Sanskrit. This gives us three options -

### **1. Exams for Central Government Jobs -**

This B.A degree course enables us all to appear for the UPSC exams. This means that we are all able to get central government jobs (possibly) in tamilnadu itself where we live and we do not need to worry about the 69% reservation in Tamilnadu government jobs and education. Thus, by taking the UPSC exams or RRB Exams or Bank Exams, we can get central government jobs in Railways, Banks or Central government offices. All these jobs are primarily 8 hour job and all of them come with compulsory annual leave and leave allowances. Yes, we have to work in these jobs also, but the work pressure will not be like in US based MNC. we can have a peaceful life and time to spend with family. We can see our kids grow instead of coming home after our children have slept. Yes of course we will not be getting salary in lakhs but we will be getting atleast 30,000 Rs basic pay plus DA and other things. This means you get atleast 50,000 Rs a month which is a lot of money.

### **2. PhD in Sanskrit -**

We can study MA and then PhD in Sanskrit from Colleges like Madras Sanskrit College or other colleges across India where they provide scholarship for PhD students. Scholarships are around 35,000 Rs per month but we have to take care of our expenses so we may be able to save only around 4 to 5 lakhs at the end of PhD. But after PhD there is a lot of scope for employment as a professor in sanskrit colleges which can lead to a career in education upto the level of Principal or Chairman of a Sanskrit College.

### **3. Agniveer Scheme -**

Did I forget to mention the Agniveer program of the Central government which hires young people directly into the defense forces like army? The Agniveer is a 4 year program by which the cadet gets four years of army training and salary of 30,000 Rs plus allowances meaning about 40 to 50 thousand Rs. The Agniveers are eligible to receive Rs 11.71 lakh as the SevaNidhi package, including interests after completion of 4 years of service. Post the period of four years, all Agniveers will go back to the society, as per the rules. This means after four years, a person will have approximately 12 to 13 lakh rupees and the name of Ex-Serviceman. This Ex-serviceman name is like a caste reservation. You can get any job you want if you are ex-serviceman, they have a special reservation for this.

**Ideally, if a Veda Padasalai or school student does 10<sup>th</sup> standard through NIOS** and studies in a Hindu based school for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> followed by a B.A in Sanskrit. He can join Agniveer. After 4 years of agniveer, he will have a minimum of 12 to 13 lakhs plus reservation for ex-serviceman. This 12-13 Lakhs can also be got after working after PhD or UPSC exams, we can buy 1 or 2 acres in our ancestral temple town and setup a gurukulam for non-brahmins till the age of 14. thus we will stop saankyam before it flows to the next generation. After the age of 14 you send them to normal schools for 9<sup>th</sup> and above. Thus you earn from guru dhakshina and you can also have some plantation like coconut or mango or jackfruit in one acre to supplement your income. Life will then be peaceful as you are only teaching small kids for a living and have a one or 1.5 acre plantation in your name. Not only that. You will have time to practice agnihotram at home in your ancestral village near your ancestral temple where you can recite the vedas further.

We have medical insurance from Modi's Ayushman Bharat Scheme and we can build a house by Modi's PM Awaas Yojana. Thus we have food from ration shop, medical insurance, our own house and gurukulam and one acre plantation. We also have EWS quota which enables us to read or get jobs if we want. Otherwise we can recite vedas, be a agnihotri, teach kids and live peacefully.

**We will not have money in lakhs but we wont have expenses either. Pls think about the above.**



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**A prize for those who read this leaflet fully:**

For those of us who have read everything and come to the end. Here is a prize - the gist of what is being conveyed. We all remember Sri Rama.. In Ramayana, there is the story of the asura called kadhanba. Sri Rama met this monster in the forest and killed him. It is said that Kadhanba had no head or neck. His mouth, eyes, ears and nose directly led to his stomach. So the asura ate, saw, heard and smelled for his stomach only. In essence, he lived for his stomach. We should not be like Kadhanba. Yes, we need to feed our stomach so we need to earn but we should not always be thinking about feeding our stomach and keep earning endlessly. That is not our goal. Our goal in life is to attain moksha. Please try to study how to attain moksha after spending a short necessary period of time in earning for your stomach. There is a sanskrit verse – “Ya vidya Sa vimukthaiyae”. That which you learn or study should lead to moksha or salvation. I am asking you to send your kids to study B.A. Sanskrit because this basic degree will open the doors to almost all central government exams where you will not be burdened with dravida imposed problems. This will give you enough earnings to live a decent life. But a degree in Sanskrit means that no matter when you want to, your children can always start learning the vedas at any age. As brahmins, veda samrakshanam is our duty. So.

1. Try to send your son aged 7 and above to traditional veda padasala (not schools that teach vedas)
2. Then, try to get a basic 10<sup>th</sup> standard certificate through NIOS.
3. **It is very important to learn english, maths and hindi before finishing 10th through NIOS. This gives the fundamental platform for your children to learn further and fly away**
4. After 10<sup>th</sup> certificate from NIOS, we can study in Hindu run schools for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> like our Hindu senior secondary school.
5. Please encourage your children to learn sanskrit during 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> so they can do B.A. Sanskrit.
6. Both Vivekananda College and Madras Sanskrit College in our mylapore, chennai offer the course B.A Sanskrit with low fees. More importantly. Madras Sanskrit College teaches vedangas.

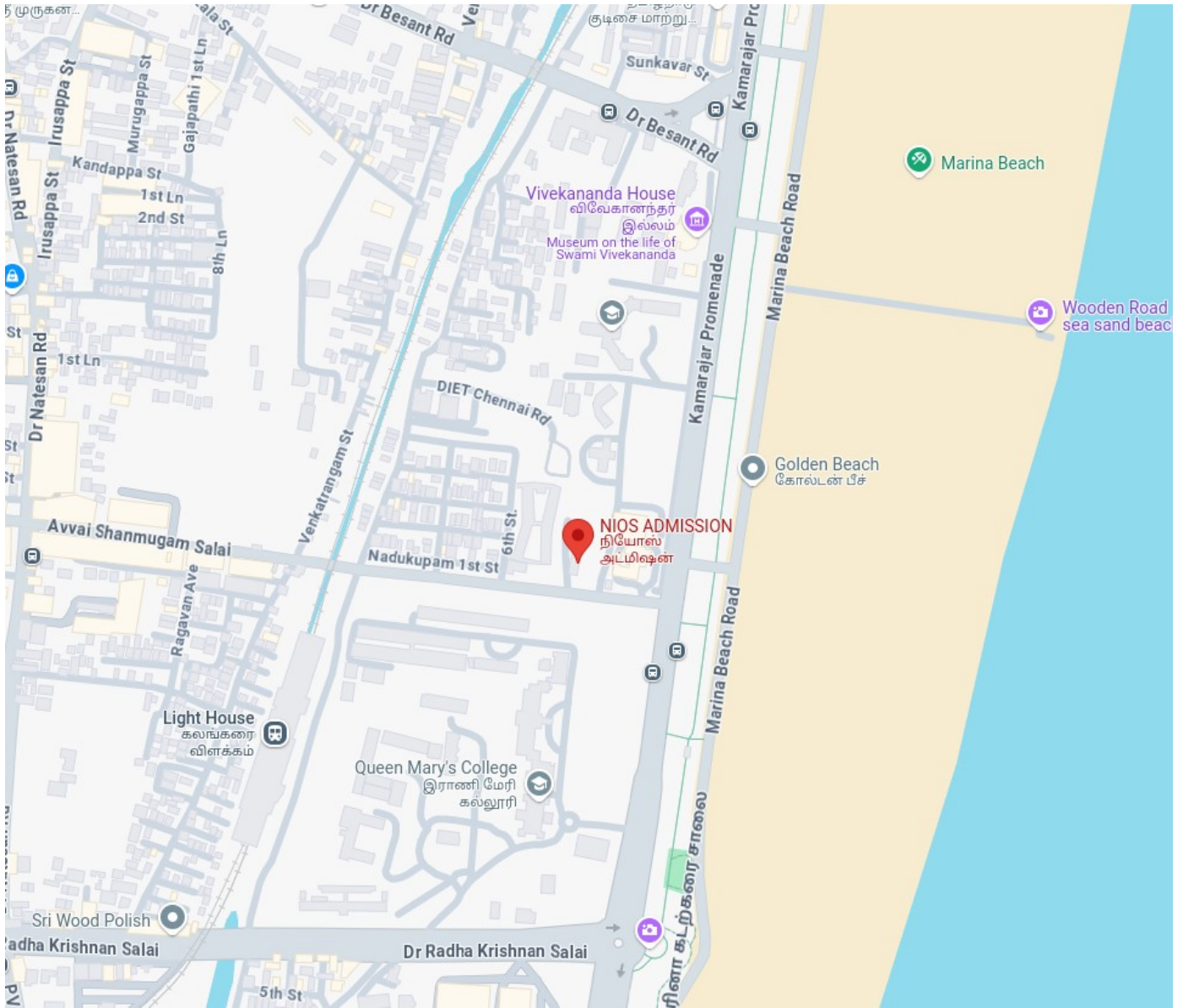
**If needed, girls can also be kept at home and given home schooling through NIOS** and taught sandhai through the many whatsapp groups. They can after maturity take up 10<sup>th</sup> in NIOS and 11<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> in Hindu schools. Thus our girl child will be protected from unwanted influences of today. The girl children can also study B.A Sanskrit so they can teach their children as they grow up or find employment if needed.
